



Adopt A "Giving Tree" Family for Christmas



You've seen the "Giving Tree" in our Narthex. And you probably know that with your help, we provide Christmas gifts for children whose parents themselves can't afford to buy much in the way of presents for their children. But you may not know that there is an even more rewarding way you can participate in our Giving Tree program... by adopting an entire family!

These are the poorest of families, where in spite of their circumstances the parents work hard at their jobs and understand the importance of education by enrolling their children in "Head Start" and similar programs. They are trying strenuously to meet life's challenges, but don't have the resources to make Christmas "Merry" for anyone in the family.

Families are available with one to seven children. You can select the family size, whether the family has one or both parents and the ages of the child(ren) that you will be helping. And you get to buy not only for the children, but also to experience the joy of putting smiles on everyone's faces by including parent and "family" gifts as well. (Children typically receive 5 or more gifts each; parent and family gifts are at your discretion).
